Institute of Catholic Liberal Arts Education School Forum Experience

Last month, two of our teachers, Jacy Short (3rd Grade) and Angela Ourth (1st Grade), were fortunate to attend the Institute for Catholic Liberal Art Education's (ICLE) School Leaders Forum at the St. Jerome Institute in Hyattsville, Maryland.

The following is their written account of their experience:

It was an incredible experience and provided us the opportunity to see Catholic Liberal Arts Education in action.

While there, it became evident that a Catholic Liberal Arts Education is


